WORSHIP GOD BECAUSE HE IS MY CREATOR,
HEAVENLY FATHER, HE LOVES ME, HE SAVED ME.

WORSHIP GOD BECAUSE HE IS MY CREATOR

Lord, I worship You as the Creator of heaven and earth. All things made by You and everything You created is good. I praise You for all our beautiful creation. You placed the earth on its foundation so that it can never be moved (Psalm 104:5). Your mighty right hand stretched out the Heavens (Isaiah 48:13). Thank You that You have blessed us with light and dark, sun and rain, food and water, land and sea, trees and flowers, days and seasons. "The heavens are Yours, the earth also is Yours; the world and all its fullness, You have founded them" (Psalm 89:11).

-When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place, what is man that you are mindful of him, the son of man that you care for him? You made him a little lower than the heavenly beings and crowned him with glory and honor. You made him ruler over the works of precious your hands; you put everything under his feet" (Psalm 8:3-6 NIV). I know that "both men and women come from God their Creator" (1 Corinthians 11 :12 TLB). "How many are your works, O LORD! In wisdom and righteousness, you have made them all; the earth is full of your creatures" (Psalm 104:24 NIV).

O Lord, thank You that You created me and gave me life. "You formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mother's womb" (Psalm 139:13). I praise You, "for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; marvelous are Your works, and that my soul knows very well" (Psalm 139:14). Lord, help me to forgive my earthly father for anything he did or did not do. Show me if there is anything I have not forgiven that I am not seeing. I don't want my lack of forgiveness to stand in the way of my intimate relationship with You. As Your child, I long to make You proud. Help me to always do what is pleasing in Your sight. PRAYERS TO SPEAK PROPHETICALLY PRAYERS TO SPEAK GOD'S WORD PROPHETICALLY

Father, I pray that when I speak, I speak truly as the very words of God. (1 Peter 4:11)

Father, this is your covenant with me as I turn from sin: Your Spirit, who is upon me, and Your words which you have put in my mouth, shall not depart from my mouth, nor from the mouth of my descendants ... from this time forth and forevermore. (Isaiah 59:21) Father, I pray that I not speak my own words. (Isaiah 58:13)

Lord Jesus, I don't want to speak from myself. That would be for my own glory. You sent me, and I am seeking your glory. I want to be totally true, and with no unrighteousness in me. (John 7:18)

Holy Spirit, teach me in all my speaking to truly speak in the name of Jesus. (Colossians 3:17)

Father, I want to mutter and meditate on your Word day and night. (Psalm 1:2)

Father, I pray that the Word of God not depart from my mouth, but that I meditate in it day and night, that I may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then I will make my way prosperous, and then I shall have good success. (Joshua 1:8)

I thank you Father that the Word is near me, in my mouth and in my heart (that is, the word of faith which we preach). (Romans 10:8)

Help me Lord to make confession of God's Word unto salvation. (Romans 10:10)

Lord, help my heart to receive the Word of God and be filled with it, because out of

the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks. (Matthew 12:34)

PROPHESYING

Lord, cause me to eagerly desire spiritual gifts, but especially that I may prophesy. (1 Corinthians 14:1)

O Lord, pour out your Spirit upon me, and cause me to prophesy and see visions. (Acts 2:17)

Help me Father always to speak to men for edification, exhortation and comfort prophetically. (1 Corinthians 14:3)

Lord, thank you for increased faith with which to prophesy. (Romans 12:6) 2.

PRAYERS TO REFRAIN FROM EVIL SPEAKING

Lord, you said, "What comes out of his mouth, this defiles a man." (Matthew 15:11)

Lord, I pray that I treasure good things, not evil things, in my heart, and that out of the abundance the good things in my heart my mouth speaks. (Matthew 12:35)

I pray that I speak evil of no man. (Titus 3:2) DON'T SLANDER

Lord, you told me not to go up and down as a talebearer, gossip or slanderer among the people. (Leviticus 19:16)

I pray I will never raise a false report. In fact, help me to never pass one on. (Exodus 23:14)

I thank you that you help me, Lord, to put away all evil speaking, that I speak no evil of a brother, and lay aside all evil speaking. (Ephesians 4:31; James 4:11; 1 Peter 2:1)

Help me Lord, where necessary, to debate my cause with my neighbor himself, and never to tell the secret to another first. (Proverbs 25:9)

Lord, you said that he who utters a slander is a fool. I don't want to be a fool in your eyes. (Proverbs 10:18)

I pray Lord that whatsoever things are ... pure ... lovely ... if there be any VIRTUE, I think on these things. (Philippians 4:8)

I pray that I not backbite, nor take up a reproach against my neighbor. (Psalm 15:1,3) MORE I pray that I do everything without complaining or arguing. (Philippians 2:14) I pray that I do not threaten those under my authority. (Ephesians 6:8)

I pray that I do not dig up evil and put it on my lips. (Proverbs 16:27)

I pray that I shun profane and vain babblings: for they increase unto more ungodliness. (2 Timothy 2:16)

Let me not even resemble an idly chattering fool, for such will fall. (Proverbs 10:10)

I pray I do not speak obscenity or foolish talking or coarse jesting, but rather giving of thanks. (Ephesians 5:4)

Lord, the perverse, defiant, contrary, complaining mouth I hate. (Proverbs 8:13)

Lord, keep me from feeding on foolishness. (Proverbs 15:14)

Lord, keep me from deceiving others and then saying I was just joking. (Proverbs 26:18,19)

Lord, keep me from lying. (Colossians 3:9) Lord, I put away from me a deceitful mouth, and perverse lips far from me. (Proverbs 4:24)

Lord, I pray that all the words of my mouth be in righteousness; there must be nothing forward or perverse in them. (Proverbs 8:8,9)

Keep me Lord from a flattering mouth, which works ruin. (Proverbs 26:28) I pray Lord that I bless those who curse me. (Luke 6:28)

Father, I pray that I bless those who persecute me; I must bless and not curse. (Romans 12:14)

Father, help me to always speak sound speech, which cannot be condemned. (Titus

2:8) Father, I pray I do not judge others, that I be not judged. (Matthew 7:1)

Father help me never to return evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary, let me return blessing. (1 Peter 3:9)

Lord, keep me from quarrelling. Let me be gentle to all, able to teach, patient, in humility correcting those who are in opposition. (2 Timothy. 2:24,25)

Keep me Lord from harsh words, which stir up anger. (Proverbs 15:1) Keep me Lord from dealing falsely, or lying to another.

I pray that I will not be a witness against my neighbor without cause, nor deceive with my lips. (Proverbs 24:28)

Lord, I have purposed that my mouth shall not transgress. (Proverbs 17:3) Lord, keep me from sinning with my tongue. (Psalm 39:1) Lord, If I ever think evil, I must put my hand upon my mouth. (Proverbs 30:32) Help me Father not to curse the king, no, not in my thought. (Ecclesiastes 10:20)

PRAYERS TO SPEAK LESS

I pray I be swift to hear; slow to speak, and slow to wrath. (James 1:19)

Lord, make me the wise one who restrains his lips. (Proverbs 10:19)

Lord, help me to remember that the perverse tongue will be cut out. (Proverbs 10:31)

LORD, MAKE ME OF A FAITHFUL SPIRIT SO AS TO CONCEAL A MATTER NOT NEEDING TO BE SAID. (PROVERBS 11:13)

Lord, keep me from being ensnared by the transgression of my lips. (Proverbs 12:13) Lord, teach me when to cover shame prudently. (Proverbs 12:16)

Lord, teach me when to conceal knowledge. Keep me from proclaiming foolishness. (Proverbs 12:23)

Teach me Lord to guard my mouth and so preserve my life. Keep me from the destruction which comes by opening my lips foolishly. (Proverbs 13:3)

Lord, intensify my hatred for lying. (Proverbs 13:5) Lord, I pray that my lips will preserve me. Keep me from proud words. (Proverbs 14:3)

Father, keep me from idle chatter and poverty. (Proverbs 14:23)

Father, give me the understanding to be slow to wrath, and not impulsive. (Proverbs 14:29)

Father, cause wisdom to rest in my heart. Give me understanding. Let me not reveal to men all that is in my heart. (Proverbs 14:33)

Lord, I pray that I speak soft answers which turn away wrath, and not harsh words which stir up anger. (Proverbs 15:1)

Lord, I pray I that be wise to use knowledge rightly, not to pour forth foolishness. (Proverbs 15:2)

Lord, I pray that I study and ponder how to answer. (Proverbs 15:28)

Lord, give me knowledge and teach me to spare my words. Give me understanding and a calm spirit. (Proverbs 17:25)

I pray Lord that I have the wisdom to hold my peace and shut my lips when it is not wise to speak. (Proverbs 17:23)

SPEAK GRACIOUSLY

Father, I thank you that as I love purity of heart, and You put grace on my lips, the king will be my friend. (Proverbs 22:11)

Pour grace upon my lips, O Father; and bless me forever. (Psalm 45:2) Make me wise and thus my words gracious; let my lips not swallow me up. (Ecclesiastes 10:12)

I pray Lord that men may marvel at the gracious words which come out of my mouth. (Luke 4.22)

I pray Lord that no corrupt communication proceeds out of my mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers. (Ephesians

4:29)

Teach me Lord to give a soft answer that turns away wrath, not harsh words that stirs up anger. (Proverbs 15:1)

Lord, let my words all be words of love, joy, peace, long-suffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. (Galatians 5:22-23)

I pray Father that I be swift to hear, slow to speak and slow to wrath; for the wrath of man does not produce the righteousness of God. (James 1:19,20)

I pray that I be slow to anger, and thus better than the mighty, and that I rule my spirit - which is greater than taking a city. (Proverbs 16:32)

PRAYERS TO SPEAK IN FAITH

Lord, remind me that whatever word is not of faith is sin. (Romans 14:23) Lord, I thank you for the faith of God. (Mark 11:22)

Lord, thank you that I can say to the works of the devil "Be Removed!" without doubting in my heart, but believing that what I say will happen, and I shall have what I say. (Mark 11:23)

Lord, help me to mix the Word with faith. (Hebrews 4:2) Lord, thank you for the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, "I believe and

therefore, I speak". So I believe all You are saying and speak it out. (2 Corinthians 4:13)

Lord, help me to preach the Word of faith. (Romans 10:8)

Lord, teach me to imitate God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did. (Ephesians 5:1; Romans 4:17)

POWERFUL BIBLICAL PRAYERS (FAITH-FILLED PRAYER, SPIRIT- FILLED PRAYERS, SPIRIT-LED PRAYERS, BIBLE-BASED PRAYERS)

PRAYER BASED ON PSALM 51

Have mercy upon me, O God, according to Your loving-kindness, according to the multitude of Your tender mercies; blot out my transgressions. Wash me completely from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.

For I know my transgressions; and my sin is ever before me. Against You, I have sinned, and done evil in Your eyes; that You might be justified in Your speaking and be clear when You judge.

Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin my mother conceived me. Behold, You desire truth in the inward parts; and in the hidden parts You teach me wisdom. Cleanse me with the precious Blood of Jesus the Lamb of God, my Messiah and Savior, the Redeemer of my soul, for I confess that Jesus is my Lord and I acknowledge his mighty power and submit to his authority; cleanse me and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. Cause me to hear joy and gladness; the bones You have crushed will rejoice. Hide Your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities. Forgive me, O God! Forgive me for offending you. Forgive me for sinning against you. Forgive all my faults. Forgive my sins against all men, against all people. Forgive my sins against my father and my mother. Forgive my sins against my brothers and sisters. Forgive my sins against my whole family. Forgive my sins against your church. Forgive my sins against the government. Forgive because I put my faith on Jesus and his sacrificial death at the Cross: "He was wounded for our transgression; he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed." (Isaiah 53:5)

Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me out from Your presence, and do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit. Then I will teach transgressors Your ways; and sinners will turn back to You. Deliver me from

the guilt of my sins, O God, O God of my salvation; my tongue shall sing aloud of Your righteousness.

O Lord, open my lips and my mouth shall declare Your praise. For you do not desire sacrifice, or I would give it; You do not delight in burnt offering. The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and a contrite heart, O God, You will not despise.

Do good in Your good pleasure to your repentant creature, to your humble servant that I am, to your born-again child. Heal me, restore me, strengthen me, make me new I pray.

(Psalm 51: 1-18)

PRAYERS TO ABIDE IN CHRIST

Lord Jesus, keep us abiding in You, and You in us. Otherwise we cannot bear fruit. Apart from you we can do nothing. We thank You that you will abide in us, and keep us looking to you. You will

keep us abiding in you all the time. We thank You that through You we will bear much fruit. (John 15:4,5)

Lord, we pray for all those not abiding in You. We pray that they will repent, and not be thrown away as worthless branches. We pray that those in the church will never dry up. We pray they will

never be cast into the fire and burn (John 15:6).

Lord, keep us in You and Your living words remaining in our hearts. We thank you for working this, and we thank you that whatever we desire we will ask, and it shall be done for us (John 15:7).

Lord, keep us in your love, which is as great as the love between You and the Father (John 15:9).

Lord, keep us walking in perfect obedience to your commandments, so that we can abide in your love and be your friends. (John 15:10,14)

Lord, let your joy remain in us, and let our joy be full (John 15:11). Lord, make us to love others with the love of the Father and so abide in you (John 15:12). Lord, live your life in us, so that our way of living is as yours (1 John 2:6).

Lord, love our brothers through us. Make us abide in the light, so that we are never a cause for anyone to stumble (1 John 2:10).

Lord, let the Word of salvation which we heard from the beginning abide in us, so that we will abide in you and in the Father (1 John 2:24).

Lord, may your Truth remain in us and with us forever (2 John 2).

Lord, thank you that your anointing abides in us. Help us to learn and apply all that the anointing teaches us (1 John 2:27)

Thank you Lord that you came to take away sins, and in You there is no sin. Thank you that as we abide in you we sin not (1 John 3:5-6).

Let us always abide in you Lord, so that we will have confidence, and not be ashamed before you

at your coming (1 John 2:28). Confessions of Thanksgiving and Faith

We thank you Lord that we keep Your commandments and so we abide in You, and You in us, because You have given us of Your Spirit. (1 John 4:13)

We thank you that we confess that You are the Son of God, God abides in us, and we in God. (1 John 4:15)

We thank You Jesus that God is love, and since we abide in love, we abide in God, and God in us. (1 John 4:16)

We thank You Father that we are in Him who is true, Jesus Christ. (1 John 5:20) 3.

- to come before the presence of God with thanksgiving. (Psalm 95:2)
- in whatever I do in word or deed, to give thanks to the Father through Christ. (Colossians 3:17)
- to do all things without complaining or arguing. (Philippians 2:14)

Thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Corinthians 15:57)

Now thanks be to God who always leads me in triumph in Christ, and through me diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place. (2 Corinthians 2:14)

PRAYERS OF THANKFULNESS CONCERNING GOD'S GOODNESS AND GENEROSITY

Thank you Father that you are good, and that your mercy is everlasting. (Psalm 100:5). Thank you Lord that you are very compassionate and merciful. (James 5:11)

Father, I thank you that your divine power has given me all things that pertain to life and godliness. (2 Peter 1:3).

I thank you God that you are for me, not against me. If you did not spare your own Son, but delivered Him up for me, I realize that you will also freely give me all

things together with Your

Son. (Romans 8:31,32).

I thank you Father that you give good things to those who ask You! I thank you that you give the Holy Spirit to those who ask you! (Matthew 7:11; Luke 11:13).

I thank you Father that I can ask, and I will receive. Thank you Father that you will give me whatever I ask you in Jesus' name! (Matthew 7:7; John 16:23)

LORD, you are my strength and my song; you also have become my salvation. Therefore, with joy let me draw water from the wells of salvation. Your joy is my strength. You are my joy and my strength. Let me know you in this way. (Isaiah 12:2,3; Nehemiah 8:10) God, you are my exceeding joy! (Psalm 43:4) Lord, make me to rejoice in you always! (Philippians 4:4)

Father God, show me the path of life. In your presence is fullness of joy, and at your right hand are pleasures for evermore. Let me experience everything in your presence and what is found at your right hand. (Psalm 16:11)

Father God, give me the oil of joy for mourning, and the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness! This is your gift and your will! (Isaiah 61:3)

LORD, your Word is to me the joy and the rejoicing of my heart! (Jeremiah. 15:16)

Lord Jesus, you want your joy to be fulfilled in me! Show me how you can make it happen! Lead me into it. (John 17:3)

LORD, I ask you to fill me with all joy and peace in believing, that I may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. (Romans 15:13)

Holy Spirit, produce your fruit of love and joy in me. (Galatians 5:22) Lord, help me to count it all joy when I fall into various trials. (James 1:2)
